

MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

FORMAT

This event is a one-day 18-hole stroke play competition. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position(s), all ties will qualify.

GENERAL

- The Golf Shop and Practice Range will open at 6:30 a.m. Range balls will be provided courtesy of Rockland Country Club.
- The Locker Room will open at 6:30 a.m.
- The verbal use of cellular phones in permitted only in the Locker Room or Parking Lot.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Registration will take place outside the Clubhouse entrance. Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Players are to report to the Starting Tent on the 1st Hole, ready to play,10 minutes before their scheduled starting time. Caddie arrangements should be completed before players report.

PRACTICE ROUND

There are no available Practice Rounds.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

FOOD SERVICE

- A continental breakfast will be provided by the MGA from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Breakfast will be located in the Clubhouse.
- Luncheon service will be available for purchase from a limited menu (Cash or Sign only) from 11:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the Garden Room.
- Players will <u>not</u> be permitted to stop and eat between nines.

CADDIES/CARTS

- There is a <u>limited</u> supply of caddies at Rockland Country Club. Caddies are available on a first come first serve basis on the day of the qualifier. The cost of a caddie is \$120 (<u>Cash</u>).
- Players will have the option to utilize a motorized golf cart, based on availability. The cost of renting a motorized golf cart is \$40 (<u>Cash or Card</u>). Payable in the Golf Shop.
- Players may bring their own caddie.
- Players may carry their own bag.
- Players are permitted to use pull carts.
- It is strongly recommended that caddies wear shoes without spikes or tread.

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all MGA Championships. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace. We appreciate your cooperation with the <u>MGA Pace of Play Policy</u>.
