



MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

FORMAT

This event is a one-day 18-hole stroke play competition. The MGA Senior Masters Tournament Champion will be the lowest score over 18 holes.

If it becomes necessary to have a playoff to determine 1st place in the Tournament, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following the conclusion of play. Ties for 2nd and 3rd places will be decided by a match of cards using the USGA's recommended method.

GENERAL

- The MGA Senior Masters Tournament is scheduled for a **1:00 p.m. shotgun**. Please see page 2 for information regarding the schedule of events.
- The Golf Shop and Practice Range will open at 11:00 a.m. Range Balls will be provided courtesy of the MGA.
- The Locker Room will open at 11:00 a.m. Players are encouraged to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do **not** change your golf shoes in the parking lot.
- The use of cellular phones is permitted **only** in the Locker Room or parking lot.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Contestants are to report to their assigned golf carts, ready to play, 10 minutes before their scheduled starting times.

PRACTICE ROUND

There are no remaining Practice Round dates available.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

LOCAL RULES

- The "One Ball Rule" will be **in effect**.
- The Local Rule **allowing** Distance Measuring Devices will be **in effect** (See App. I-B-9).
- The New Local Rule for Accidental Movement of a Ball on the Putting Green will be **in effect**.

FOOD SERVICE

- Luncheon service will be provided by the MGA from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. under the Pavilion.
- Players will **not** be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

CARTS/CADDIES

- Players are **required** to take golf carts. Golf carts will be provided courtesy of the MGA.
- Players are **required** and will be assigned a club caddie. The club caddie putter fee is \$40.00 including tip per person.
- Players may **not** bring their own caddie.
- Players may **not** carry their own bag.
- Players are **not** permitted to use pull carts.

AWARDS RECEPTION

All contestants will be guests of the MGA for an awards reception immediately following play.

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that “the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish” and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all MGA competitions. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace.
