MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

FORMAT – PINEHURST (18 HOLES, STROKE PLAY)

Both partners tee off from their assigned tee and then each plays a second shot with the other's ball. After the second shot, a choice is made regarding the ball with which the hole will be completed. Alternating shots will be continued until the hole is completed. On par three holes, the choice must be made after the tee shots.

GENERAL

- The Golf Shop and Practice Range (**270 yard max**) will open at 7:00 a.m. Range balls will be provided courtesy of the MGA.
- The Locker Room will open at 7:00 a.m. Players are encouraged to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do **not** change your golf shoes in the parking lot.
- The use of cellular phones is permitted **only** in Cell Phone Booths or the parking lot.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Contestants are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their scheduled starting times. Caddie arrangements should be completed before players report.

PRACTICE ROUND

Players have been accorded the courtesy of a practice round **after 12:00pm on Wednesday, October 10th and Monday, October 15th.**

Players must contact the Caddie Manager, Keith Hernandez, at (914) 241-0700 ext. 223 or email at khernandez@glenarborclub.com to make arrangements on a first call basis. The cost of a practice round is \$85 for a double or \$50 for a single (**cash only**), which includes the **mandatory** use of a motorized golf cart. Limited availability and **no** guests allowed. Standard club policies apply.

Players are **only** permitted to use the practice facilities of GlenArbor Golf Club on the day of their scheduled practice round **and** one hour before/after their scheduled practice round.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

FOOD SERVICE

- A continental breakfast will be provided by the MGA from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. on the patio.
- Luncheon service will be provided by the MGA from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on the patio.
- Players will **not** be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

CARTS/CADDIES

- Players are **required** to use a motorized golf cart. The golf cart fee is \$85.00 (**credit or sign**) per team.
- There is a strong supply of caddies at GlenArbor Golf Club. Players must contact Keith Hernandez, Caddie Manager, at (914) 241-0700 ext. 223, to reserve a club caddie on a first-call basis. The caddie fee for the MGA Father/Son Championship for is \$150.00 per team, including tip.
- Players may **not** carry their own bag.
- Pull carts are **not** permitted.

- The Local Rule for Accidental Movement of a Ball on a Putting Green will be **in effect**.
- The Local Rule **allowing** Distance Measuring Devices ('DMD') will be **in effect** (See D14-3/0.5).

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all MGA competitions. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace.
