

MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

FORMAT

This event is a one-day 18-hole stroke play competition. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position(s), all ties will qualify.

GENERAL

- The Golf Shop and Practice Range (irons only) will open at 6:30 a.m. Range balls will be available for purchase for \$5.00 payable at the Golf Shop or the Practice Range.
- The Locker Room will open at 6:30 a.m. Players are encouraged to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do <u>not</u> change your golf shoes in the parking lot.
- The use of cellular phones is permitted **only** in the Locker Room and inside a car in the parking lot.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Contestants are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their scheduled starting times. Caddie arrangements should be completed before players report.

PRACTICE ROUND

Players have been accorded the courtesy of a practice round after 3:00 p.m. on:

Thursday, May 4

Players must call the Knollwood Golf Shop, at (914) 592-7411 to make arrangements on a first-call basis. The cost of a practice round is \$35.00 (cash or credit only) which includes the optional use of a motorized golf cart. Players may carry their own bag or take a club caddie for \$75.00 (tip <u>not</u> included). Limited availability and <u>no</u> guests or caddies allowed. Standard club policies apply.

Players are <u>only</u> permitted to use the practice facilities of Knollwood Country Club on the day of their scheduled practice round <u>and</u> arrive no earlier than one hour before their scheduled practice round.

Please note: Due to ongoing construction on **Hole #12**, this Sectional Qualifying Round will be played on Holes #1-11, #13-18, and the club's Par 3 **19**th **Hole** as the 18th Hole.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

FOOD SERVICE

- A continental breakfast will be provided by the MGA from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. in the Grill Room and back patio area.
- Luncheon service will be available for purchase (<u>cash or sign only</u>) from 11:30 a.m. 3:00 p.m. on the back patio.
- Players will <u>not</u> be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

CARTS/CADDIES

- Players may use a motorized golf cart. The golf cart fee is \$35.00 (cash or credit) per person payable in the Golf Shop.
- There is a limited supply of caddies at Knollwood Country Club. Players must contact Tom McGirr, Caddie Manager at (914) 592-7411 to reserve a club caddie on a first-call basis. The caddie fee for the WGA Open SQR is \$75.00 (tip <u>not</u> included).
- Players may bring their own caddie.
- Players may carry their own bag.
- Players are <u>not</u> permitted to use pull carts.
- It is strongly encouraged that caddies wear shoes without spikes or tread.

LOCAL RULES

- Please check at the starter's table for the Local Rules and the USGA website (<u>www.usga.org</u>) for a list of approved golf balls & drivers for the competition.
- The Condition of Competition ("Groove Rule") will be in effect (see Condition Section Below).
- The "One Ball Rule" will be in effect.
- The Local Rule <u>allowing</u> Distance Measuring Devices will be <u>in effect</u> (See App. I-B-9).
- The New Local Rule for Accidental Movement of a ball on the Putting Green will be in effect.

"GROOVE AND PUNCH MARK SPECS" CONDITION

Clubs: Grooves – The player's clubs must conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Rules of Golf that are effective from January 1, 2010 – See Decision 4-1/1 and applicable championship entry for details.

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all WGA Championships. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace. We appreciate your cooperation with the <u>MGA Pace of Play Policy</u>.
