

MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

10:00am SHOTGUN

FORMAT

This event is a one-day 18-hole Four-Ball Stroke Play competition. There will be a sudden death playoff to determine the champion (1st Place Net). If necessary, all other prizes will be determined by a matching of cards, using the USGA's recommended method.

All male contestants shall compete at 90% of their current Course Handicap on a net better-ball basis. The USGA Rules for Four-Ball Stroke Play shall govern all play. Players should familiarize themselves with Rule 31 in the USGA Rules of Golf. Handicap Indexes will be used as of the <u>October 1st revision</u>.

HANDICAPS

Under Rule 6-2, it is the player's responsibility to know his correct current Handicap Index. Please check at your club on or after October 1st to determine your current USGA Handicap Index (the decimal number). You will not play with your Home Course Handicap and it is not necessary to know the Slope Rating for your home course - just your USGA Handicap Index. The MGA will convert your USGA Handicap Index into a Course Handicap for the competition using the Morris County Golf Club Handicap Table. If you have any questions regarding handicaps, please call the MGA Championship Department.

GENERAL

- The Golf Shop and Practice Range will open at 8:00 a.m. Range balls will be provided courtesy of the MGA.
- The Locker Room will open at 8:00 a.m. Players are encouraged to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do <u>not</u> change your golf shoes in the parking lot.
- The use of cellular phones is permitted **only** in the parking lot.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Contestants are to report to their carts, ready to play, 15 minutes before the scheduled starting time.

AWARDS CEREMONY AND COCKTAIL RECEPTION

Following the conclusion of play, all players are encouraged to join the MGA at nearby **Spring Brook Country Club** for the 2018 MGA/MetLife Four-Ball Championships Awards Ceremony and Cocktail Reception. The Cocktail Reception will begin in the Dining Room of Spring Brook Country Club at 3:30 p.m.

Lunch and hors d'oeuvres will be provided courtesy of the MGA and MetLife. There will be a cash bar open to all participants during the Cocktail Reception and Awards Ceremony as well.

Players are responsible for their own transportation from Morris County Golf Club to Spring Brook Country Club. Spring Brook Country Club is 5.4 miles from Morris County Golf Club, directions will be provided to each participant.

PRACTICE ROUND

Unfortunately, due to the abnormal weather resulting in rescheduled events, there will be no Practice Rounds available.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

FOOD SERVICE

- Breakfast will be provided by the MGA from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. on the Covered Terrace.
- Players will not be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

CARTS/CADDIES

- Players are <u>required</u> to use a motorized golf cart. The golf cart fee for the MGA/MetLife Four-Ball Championship is \$45.00 (<u>cash or sign</u>) per player.
- Players will be able to reserve one club forecaddie per group. The club forecaddie fee for the MGA/MetLife Four-Ball Championship is \$40.00 (including tip) per player. Players may reserve a club forecaddie by contacting Carl Corsentinto, Caddie Manager, at (973) 539-7200.
- Players may **<u>not</u>** bring their own caddie.
- Players may <u>not</u> carry their own bag.
- Players are not permitted to use pull carts.

LOCAL RULES

- Please check at the starter's table for the Local Rules and the USGA website (<u>www.usga.org</u>) for a list of approved golf balls & drivers for the competition.
- The "One Ball Rule" will not be in effect.
- The Local Rule <u>allowing</u> Electronic Measuring Devices will be <u>in effect</u> (See App. I-A-7).
- The New Local Rule for Accidental Movement of a Ball on the Putting Green will be in effect.

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all MGA Championships. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace. We appreciate your cooperation with the <u>MGA Pace of Play Policy</u>.
