MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

FORMAT

This event is a 36-hole stroke play competition with a cut to the low 40 players and ties after 18 holes. In the event of a tie after 36 holes, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following regulation play.

GENERAL

- The practice range will open at 6:30 a.m. (**185 yard maximum**). Balls will be provided courtesy of Nassau CC.
- The Golf Shop and Locker Room will be open at 6:30 a.m.
- Molded bottom shoes without plastic spikes or rubber shoes are <u>highly encouraged</u> to maintain the consistency of the greens throughout the championship. Please be aware of the marks you make on the greens and tap down any marks before leaving each green.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Players are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes prior to their scheduled starting time. Caddie arrangements should be completed before players report.

PRACTICE ROUND

There are no LIGA administered practice rounds available for this Championship.

FOOD SERVICE

- A continental breakfast will be provided by the LIGA from 6:30 10:00 a.m. each day of the Championship
 on the Lower Terrace.
- All players will be guests of the LIGA for Lunch on each day of the Championship from 11:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m. on the Lower Terrace (spectators and caddies should be prepared to pay cash).
- An Awards reception will be held immediately following the conclusion of play on Day 2 on the Upper Terrace.
- Players will <u>not</u> be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply. Molded bottom shoes without plastic spikes or rubber shoes are highly encouraged to maintain the consistency of the greens throughout the championship. Please be aware of the marks you make on the greens and tap down any marks before leaving each green.

CADDIES

- There is a <u>limited supply</u> of caddies at Nassau CC. Players must contact Darren Wetzel at play@nassaucc.com, to reserve a club caddie on a first-call basis. The caddie fee for the Long Island Mid-Amateur is \$120.00 per player (<u>tip not included</u>).
- This is a walking only event.
- Players may bring their own caddie.
- Players may carry their own bag.
- Pull carts are not permitted.

LOCAL RULES

- Please check at the starter's table for the Local Rules and the USGA website (<u>www.usga.org</u>) for a list of approved golf balls & drivers for the competition.
- The "One Ball Rule" will be not in effect.

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all MGA Championships. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace. We appreciate your cooperation with the MGA Pace of Play Policy.
