Please Note that the 9's will be flipped for the Championship. All starting tees and yardage will be communicated in the Championship Routing terms (players starting on Hole #1 are starting on Plainfield CC Hole #10)

### **GENERAL**

- The use of distance measuring devices, including GPS-based systems and laser rangefinders, are **permitted** during Met Junior Championships, Pro Junior Championship and qualifying rounds (see Local Rules).
- The Pro Shop and Practice Range will open at 6:30 a.m. each day of the Championship.

The MGA....So You Can Play

- The Locker Room will open at 6:30 a.m. Players are <u>required</u> to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do not change your golf shoes in the parking lot.
- The use of cellular phones is permitted **only** in the parking lot.

## **DRESS**

Proper golf attire will be required at all times at Plainfield CC. Under no circumstances will jeans, cargo shorts, cut-offs, mock shirts, t-shirts or tank tops be permitted. Bermuda length shorts are permitted. Shirts must be tucked in and hats must face forward. All spectators are asked to adhere to the player's dress code.

## **GOLF SHOES**

Shoes with traditionally designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either or partially of metal (when such metal comes in contact with the surface of the putting green) are **prohibited**. Penalty for breach of this condition: **Disqualification**.

#### FOOD SERVICE

- Breakfast will be provided by the MGA beginning at 7:00 a.m. on the back patio.
- Luncheon service will be available for Tuesday through Thursday from 11:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on the back patio.
- Players will **not** be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

### **CADDIES**

<u>MGA/MetLife Pro-Junior</u>: Caddies will be provided for the professionals and past champions at the MGA's expense. Each professional will be teamed with up to three juniors, including his host. Juniors <u>must</u> carry their own bags.

Met Junior Championship: No caddies or pull carts will be allowed; Players must carry their own bags.

## **TRANSPORTATION**

Players must provide their own transportation to and from Plainfield Country Club.

#### **SPECTATORS**

Spectators will be permitted to <u>WALK ONLY</u> along with the matches. Please remember it is a violation of Rule 8-1 for a player to seek or accept advice from <u>ANYONE</u>. We respectfully remind all spectators to maintain a safe distance from the players <u>at all times</u>.

### LOCAL RULES

- Please check at the starter's table for the Local Rules and the USGA website (<u>www.usga.org</u>) for a list of approved golf balls & drivers for the competition.
- The "One Ball Rule" will be in effect.
- The Local Rule allowing Electronic Measuring Devices will be in effect (See App. I-B-9).

# **DIRECTIONS:**

### PLAINFIELD COUNTRY CLUB

Woodland Avenue, Plainfield, NJ 07061 (908) 769-3672 -Pro Shop-(908) 757-1800 Club Garden State Parkway Northbound OR Southbound to Exit 131:

- Turn right (Route 127) and proceed to Wood Avenue (1st light), turn right.
- Proceed to top of hill, Oak Tree Road (1st light), turn left.
- Proceed 2.7 miles to Woodland Avenue (Edison Church Playhouse on corner), turn right.
- Proceed 1.3 miles to Club on Right.

## NJ Turnpike.:

- To exit 14 to 22 West to (The Plainfields) exit... continue on Somerset Street to end, S curve becomes Park Avenue.

- Proceed 2.1 miles to Maple Avenue (at stop light) turn left (Route 602 east)
- Proceed 4-5 blocks to Woodland Avenue, at light turn right Club on left.
