MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

COVID-19 GUIDELINES

The MGA has released COVID-19 Guidelines for MGA-Sanctioned events. Please reference this document before arriving to the event. <u>CLICK HERE</u> for the MGA COVID-19 Guidelines.

FORMAT

This event is a one-day 18-hole stroke play competition. If necessary to determine the qualifiers and/or alternates, there will be a sudden death playoff which will begin immediately at the conclusion of regular play. All players should keep informed as to the time and status of any playoff.

GENERAL

- All players are required to have their own face mask/ covering while they are on property.
- The Golf Shop and Practice Range will be open at 6:30 a.m. Practice Balls will be available to purchase for <u>\$5 (Cash).</u>
- The Locker Room will be open at 6:30 a.m.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. We ask players not arrive earlier than 45 minutes prior to their starting time. Players are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, immediately after the prior tee time has left the teeing area. Caddie arrangements should be completed before players report.

PRACTICE ROUND

Players have been accorded the courtesy of one practice round on the following dates:

• Monday – Thursday: August 24, 25, 26 & 27.

Players must call the Springdale Golf Shop at (609) 921-8790 to make arrangements on a first-call basis. The practice round fee is **\$45 (Cash or Card)** and is payable in the Golf Shop. Standard club policies apply.

Players will not be permitted to bring guests and must arrive no earlier than one hour before their scheduled practice round.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

FOOD SERVICE

- A continental breakfast will be provided by the MGA from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.
- Luncheon service will be available for purchase (cash or sign only) from 11:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- Players will <u>not</u> be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

CARTS/CADDIES

- There are <u>no</u> Caddies available at Springdale Golf Club.
- Players may bring their own caddie.
- Players may carry their own bag.
- Players are permitted to use pull carts.

- The "One Ball Rule" will be in effect.

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all MGA Championships. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace. We appreciate your cooperation with the <u>MGA Pace of Play Policy</u>.
