

MEMORANDUM TO PLAYERS

FORMAT

This event is a one-day 18-hole stroke play competition. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position(s) for the <u>Junior Championship</u>, all ties will qualify. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position(s) for the <u>Boys</u> <u>Championship</u>, there will be a sudden death playoff which will begin immediately at the conclusion of play. All players in contention for the Boys Championship should keep informed as to the time and status of any playoff.

GENERAL

- The competition will be played on the **<u>Red and Blue</u>** nines.
- The Golf Shop and Practice Range will open at 7:00 a.m. Range Balls will be available for purchase for \$6.00 (cash only) at the Practice Range.
- The Locker Room will open at 7:00 a.m. Players are encouraged to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do <u>not</u> change your golf shoes in the parking lot.

REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Contestants are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their scheduled starting times.

PRACTICE ROUND

Players may utilize the Timber Point Golf Course <u>online reservation system</u>, or call (631) 581-2401 to schedule a practice round.

DRESS

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

FOOD SERVICE

- A continental breakfast will be provided by the MGA from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. in the Dining Room.
- Luncheon service will be available for purchase (cash only) beginning at 11:30 a.m. at the Halfway House.
- Players will not be permitted to stop to eat between nines.

CADDIES

- Players must carry their own bag.
- Players may not use a pull cart.
- Caddies are **<u>not permitted</u>** during MGA Junior Championships or qualifying rounds.

LOCAL RULES

- Please check at the starter's table for the Local Rules and the USGA website (<u>www.usga.org</u>) for a list of approved golf balls & drivers for the competition.
- The Condition of Competition ("Groove Rule") will be in effect (see Condition Section Below).
- The "One Ball Rule" will be in effect.
- The Local Rule **<u>allowing</u>** Distance Measuring Devices will be **<u>in effect</u>** (See App. I-B-9).
- The New Local Rule for Accidental Movement of a Ball on the Putting Green will be in effect.

PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be closely monitoring the POP at all MGA Championships. Chronic slow play takes away much of the enjoyment of the game of golf and we ask that you please be courteous of your pace. We appreciate your cooperation with the <u>MGA Pace of Play Policy</u>.
