

## FORMAT

This event is a one-day 18-hole stroke play competition. If necessary, to determine low male and female scorer, there will be a sudden death playoff which will begin immediately at the conclusion of play.

**Maximum Score Format:** The maximum score for each hole is double par. Players are asked to pick up if they reach the maximum score.

### **GENERAL**

- The Golf Shop and Practice Range will open at 7:30 a.m. Range balls will be provided courtesy of the MGA.
- The Locker Room will open at 7:30 a.m.
- The use of cellular phones is permitted only in the Locker Room, in the parking lot, and in case of emergency.
- Wheelchairs will also be available at Haworth Country Club.

### **REGISTRATION AND START OF PLAY**

Players are requested to check in upon their arrival at the course. Contestants are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their scheduled starting times. Caddie arrangements should be completed before players report.

### **DRESS**

Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited. The Committee in charge decides whether this requirement has been met and has authority to withdraw the entry of a player who does not comply.

### FOOD SERVICE

- A continental breakfast will be provided by the MGA from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. in the Banquet Room.
- Luncheon service will be available for purchase for <u>\$20 per person</u> from 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m in the Banquet Room.
- Players will not be permitted to stop in the clubhouse to eat between nines.
- Players are encouraged to bring their own snacks.

#### CADDIES

- There is no caddie program at Haworth Country Club.
- Players <u>may</u> use a motorized golf cart. The golf cart fee is \$40.00 (cash or credit) per cart payable in the Golf Shop.
- Please notify the MGA at <u>marissa.colvin@mgagolf.org</u> for all questions regarding seated carts if needed.
- Players **may** bring their own caddie.
- Players **are** permitted to use pull carts.
- It is strongly recommended that caddies wear shoes without spikes or tread.

### LOCAL RULES

- The Condition of Competition ("Groove Rule") will be in effect.

# PACE OF PLAY

It is a condition of the competition that "the Player shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play (POP) guidelines that the Committee may establish" and with the prescribed penalties for slow play. The MGA will be using the 2023 U.S. Adaptive Open Championship Pace of Play Policy. We appreciate your cooperation with the <u>USGA Pace of Play Policy</u>.
