	The Professional/Host is responsible for maintaining the scorecard of the team. At the completion of the round, the scorecard shall be signed by the Professional/Host and attested by one of the team members. Penalties for violations shall be consistent with other scoring rules (see Rule 6-6).

Registration:	Outside the Men's Locker Room.
Locker Room:	The Locker Room will be available at 6:30 a.m. Players are encouraged to change their golf shoes in the Locker Room. Please do not change your golf shoes in the parking lot.
Caddies:	All players will be assigned two club caddies. The base fee for the caddies is being paid courtesy of the MGA, and each player is asked to provide a \$40 gratuity to your caddie.

Pace of Play:	All players should be conscious of their pace of play and maintain contact with the group ahead of them. If your ball cannot help your team on a given hole you are encouraged to pick up.
Dress Code:	Players must be neat in appearance with respect to clothing and personal grooming. Players and caddies must wear collared shirts. The wearing of jeans, cargo shorts, and cargo pants is prohibited.
Reception:	Players are encouraged to join us for a Cocktail Reception following the end of play. Awards will be distributed during the cocktail reception following the end of play. The MGA will ship awards to those participants who are not present to collect their award at the reception.
Course Setup:	There will be separate three sets of tees; Professionals (~6,700 yards) and male amateur (~6,400 yards) & (~5,800) female amateurs.
